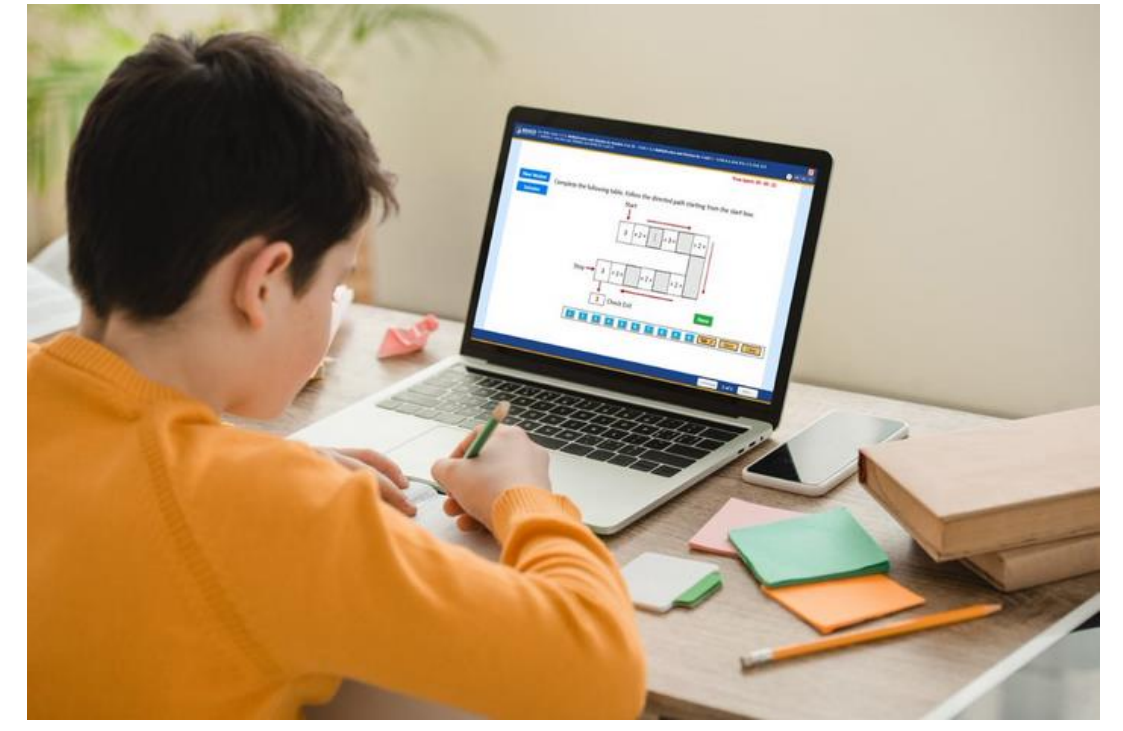

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Benefits of Taking the Diagnostic Test

Identifying strengths and weaknesses:

The diagnostic test helps to identify the areas where the student is strong and the areas where they need improvement. This information can be used to guide future study and practice.

Personalized learning:

A diagnostic test can help to customize the learning experience by tailoring the content and pace to the student's needs and abilities.

Measuring progress:

By taking a diagnostic test at the beginning of a course, a student can measure their progress and see how much they have learned in their previous grade.

Focusing study:

Signing up for a Free Diagnostic Test



1 Go to the ELC website:

Open a web browser and go to www.educolearningcenter.com and Click on the Start Now button on the Diagnostic window

2 Create an account:


If you don't already have an ELC account, you'll need to create one. Click on the "Sign Up" button and fill out the form with your name, email address, and password.

3 Select Child's grade:

During the signup process, select your child's grade and enter your child's name information.

4 Submit the form:

After entering the information click on "Submit" button. Child login credential will be emailed to parent registered email address

- 1 Once you receive the registration confirmation email, use your child's login credentials to log on to the ELC platform.
- 2 On the dashboard navigate to the diagnostic test for the subject. Click on the 'Take Diagnostic Test' button to begin the test.
- 3 Read the Assessment Instruction(s) and click on the 'Start' button.
- 4 Answer all the questions and click on the 'Submit' button. Upon submission, the user will be redirected to the result screen.
- 5 Students can also see their detailed Diagnostic Test report thru the dashboard at a future point in time.

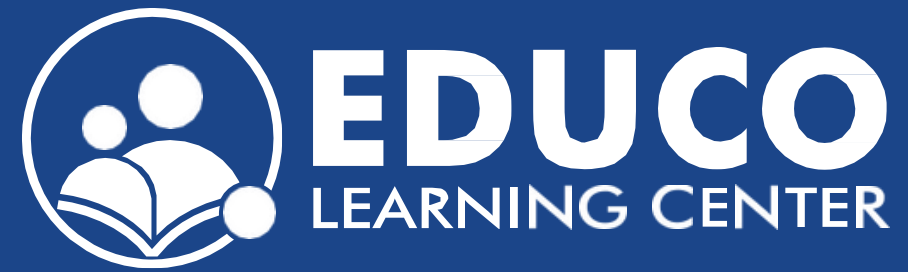

- 1 On the dashboard, click on the 'View' button corresponding to the grade title
